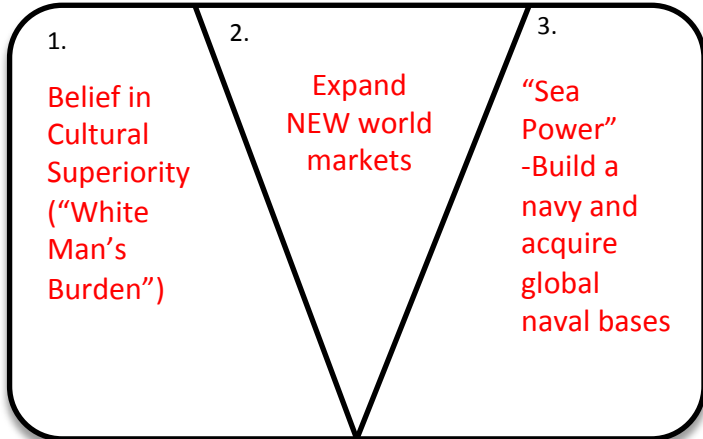

PRESIDENTIAL DIPLOMACIES

ROOSEVELT

Define ROOSEVELT COROLLARY
 This was an amendment to the Monroe Doctrine.. It stated that the U.S. would intervene in Latin American affairs when necessary to maintain peace and stability in the Western Hemisphere.

Define BIG STICK DIPLOMACY
 Assertion of U.S. dominance Navy is the Big Stick

TAFT

Define DOLLAR DIPLOMACY
 The effort of the US to further its aims in LA through use of its economic power by guaranteeing loans made to foreign countries.

WILSON

Define MORAL DIPLOMACY
 the system in which support is given only to countries whose moral beliefs are similar to that of the democratic US.
